Applications are available at the Christmas Station as well as online at www.bedfordchristmasstation.org. Applications cannot be mailed in nor turned in at any location other than the Christmas Station. Applications may only be submitted during the dates and times above. Late applications will not be accepted.

Applicants will need to bring:

Photo ID, Proof of address, Proof of total household income, Insurance card or birth certificate for each child, and school documents if the child is enrolled in school (homeschooled children will need verification of approval from county or enrollment in home school program)

Proof of child custody may be required as well.

To be eligible, households must reside in Bedford County, earn a low income, and include a child under 18 or 18 but still enrolled in high school, a senior citizen aged 60 and older, and/or a disabled adult.
