BCHF, the Town of Bedford and Ride Source entered into a collaborative agreement to provide a fixed route in the Town that would provide citizens with access to the resources necessary to live a healthy and connected life. The Town of Bedford applied for and received a grant from the Virginia Department of Public Rail and Transportation to provide a fixed-route bus service in the town. The Bedford Community Health Foundation provides the matching funds required and Ride Source provides the service.
