- 1. Action Group Report Outs (Chairs or Designee)
 - a. Aging/Elder Care Action Group held an event at the Outpost that was well attended. The next event will be held on May 9th. The Group is working with Denise Scruggs at the Beard Center on a Survey. The Group is also working on a mentor program.
 - b. Child Care- The action group has not met. The YMCA building is not yet open. They hope to move in June 1st for 3-4 year olds and hopefully have the other ages July 1st. Preschool Kingdom Builders at 403 Otey Street is hoping to opening in a few weeks for birth to 5. They will start with 16 months to 5. They have about 10 slots left. They will be a subsidy vendor. Long term goal is birth-12th grade.
 - c. Healthy Foods Action Group has met and has tried to do something with the Farmers Market this Spring/Summer and will work to do another event in the Fall at Elba Butcher Shop.
 - d. Housing April meeting is cancelled for today. There are talks about a cooling shelter. If anyone is aware of any unsheltered groups of 5 or more let the Housing Coalition know so that the Street Outreach through CHIA can come in person and provide services. They are worker on home repairs. Habitat for Humanity looking for a board member and a selection member.
 - e. Employment and Training Working with Lake Christian Ministries to connect participants with employment. VA Career Works is having a lot of job fairs.
 - f. Minds Together- Meetings are the 1st Thursday of the month from 10-11. Shiloh Martin with Project Link did a training in April. Progress is being made towards Strategic Plan Goals.


